Update3 on 2017 Homeless Count

Presenter: Anna Jacobsen

- 575 total homeless persons in 2017, up 8% (45 persons) from 2016
 - 347 unsheltered persons were counted in 2017 vs 352 in 2016
 - 228 sheltered persons were counted in 2017 vs 178 in 2016
- The colder weather is believed to have had an effect on the sheltered count this year
- Both the youth and senior count went down this year
- Veteran count went down from 40 in 2016 to 30 in 2017
- Families increased from 77 in 2016 to 109 in 2017. There were 4 unsheltered families counted in 2017 vs 1 unsheltered family in 2016. We were reminded that as long as we have family shelters in Pasadena, we will always have homeless families in our count.
- The numbers will be finalized and the complete report will be posted on the Pasadena Partnership website
