

Pasadena Partnership to End Homelessness

Housing Committee Meeting Minutes

October 22, 2015

In Attendance: Anne Lansing, Pasadena Dept. of Housing; Anna Jacobsen, Pasadena Dept. of Housing; Cheryl Castillo, Alliance for Housing and Healing

- I. PSH Bous for CoC Application
 - a. 2 Applications Received
 - i. Affordable Housing Services to build bricks & mortar 4 units \$225K
 - ii. Union Station to provide 20 scattered site units using sponsored based approach \$441K – scored higher
 - iii. Union Station application has been chosen to be included in the application &

- II. Tier 1 & Tier 2 Ranking Projects have to be placed in Tier 1 & Tier 2
 - i. Tier 2 is 15%
 - ii. All Renewal Projects are PSH except for HMIS
 - iii. 3 Renewal Projects that have just started operations or have not started operations; consultant states that putting these projects in Tier 2 would likely result in them not being funded
 - iv. Will look at outcomes to determine who will be placed in Tier 2, if ties exist, will look at homeless count needs, which puts Alliance and Hestia House at risk due to specific populations served that are not needs in Pasadena homeless count
 - v. Hope is that HUD will fund PH over making clients who are housed homeless
 - vi. Will take methodology to CoC board to get approval before moving forward with ranking

- III. CoC Rental Assistance / Rapid Re-housing Mobility
 - a. Pasadena CoC is considering using NOFA surrounding CoC funds being expended in other communities to provide rental assistance and rapid re-housing mobility
