  - A. Housing First Support and Resources- Philosophy and practice developed from research
    - 1. Connects individuals and families experiencing homelessness to Permanent Supportive Housing (PSH)
    - 2. No barrier to housing (income requirements, sobriety, treatment and service participation, criminal record, dv)
    - 3. No related preconditions that may lead to termination; supportive services offered but not requirement for person(s) to stay housed
  - B. Bridge Housing- 90 day stop-gap place for chronically and non-chronically homeless people waiting for housing, has extensive services
  - C. Establishing Future Meetings
    - Mapping Homeless Services- collect current data for services in the Continuum of Care (COC) and outside and assess where Pasadena's agencies Housing First Awareness and Alignment
      - a. Action Step: Dan, Andrew, Terry, Anna to utilize Housing Inventory Chart 2010
    - 2. Landlord Outreach Efforts
      - a. City is working with Anderson School to develop housing voucher campaign
      - b. Pasadena vacancy rate is below 2 %, many people on wait list for years
      - c. FCC- continue to reach out to faith-based community members, organize effort
      - 1. Action Item- Dan connect with marketing company and Anderson University
    - 3. Homeless Count Snapshot Model- receiving demographic and location information helps us know what homelessness looks like throughout the year, task of FCC
    - 4. Homeless Count as official task of FCC- assist in recruiting volunteers and aiding Office for Urban Initiatives
      - a. Action Item- devote one meeting to plan before May
    - 5. Religious Leaders Training- continuing work from last year
