<b>Introductions</b>		Presenter: Anne Lansing
<p>We are down two Board Members as Jennifer Addington has moved on from her role with the City of Pasadena and Tashera Taylor's organization, Foothill Unity Center, is now an ESG recipient and therefore not eligible to be a board member. <b>Review LOIs</b>		Presenter: Anne Lansing
<p>The Pasadena Partnership (Pasadena CoC) issued an LOI in June for renewal grants to be including in the 2016 CoC Program application. We have done the reallocation we need to do with TH and all of our renewals now are PH, HMIS, or SSO (CES projects).</p> <p>All of the LOI renewal submissions scored very highly and consequently, no projects were recommended for reallocation. We do expect, however, to need to reallocate in future years and will be reviewing the rating and ranking criteria before next year's LOI to ensure a more even distribution of scores as HUD requires a certain percent of project funding to be placed in Tier 2 (approx. \$215k this year).</p> <p>One note on the scoring is that there was a discrepancy in wording between what HUD is asking for in the 2016 NOFA regarding client income and what projects have been reporting on in their APRS. In the 2016 NOFA, HUD uses the systems performance measure which looks at whether a client has increased their income. In the APRs, however, programs have been reporting on whether clients have increased or maintained their income. For our CoC, sub-recipients have a much higher percent of clients who maintain income than those who increase income. Participants are often on SSI when they are placed in housing and because they are the most vulnerable population, increasing their income is an inherent challenge with HUD's new measure. Nevertheless, this new system performance measure will need to be used in scoring LOIs.</p> <p>Staff made recommendations for Tier 1 and Tier 2 projects based on LOI score using the CoC 2016 Ranking and Review criteria, placing Alliance for Housing &amp; Healing's CHOISS project in Tier 2. A motion to approve the ranking of projects was made, seconded, and unanimously approved by the Board.</p> <p>The next step is to bring these recommendations to City Council on Aug 15<sup>th</sup> – this is generally a consent calendar item, however because of the timing this year, it may be moved off the consent calendar and into an agenda item (in which case the Board is encouraged and welcome to come).</p>
