Is your family homeless or at risk of losing your housing? We can help! The Coordinated Entry System (CES) is the primary point of entry for families seeking housing services in the San Gabriel Valley. Access services by following the process laid out below.

1. Dial 2-1-1 to reach the Los Angeles County Information & Referral line.

2. Request a screening with a Regional Family Solutions Center (FSC).

3. An Assessment interview will help determine the most appropriate services.
